This seminar aims to provide a sociological understanding of the forms of social protection available to asylum seekers and refugees in Italy, and of their reception and housing pathways, by connecting three streams of research and practice: social welfare, refugee studies, and home. The seminar will be 20 hours long. It will involve both class teaching (11 hours) and students' participation to the international conference "Tackling the migration and refugee challenge" (9 hours). The latter event is promoted by the network EMES EMPOWER-SE and by the FARE-MIUR project HOASI. It will take place at the Dpt. of Sociology on November 22-23 2018.

The seminar is addressed to all students of the University of Trento, with a priority given to those enrolled in Laurea Magistrale MOVASS.

As far as the students of DSRS (Dpt. of Sociology and Social Research) are concerned, participation to at least **75%** of the seminar, and to the assignments set by the lecturer (i.e. final article presentation and discussion), will result in **3 CFU** ("crediti formativi universitari").
