Although the intention to reform the Ottoman state started in the 19th century, the establishment of the republican Turkish state, in 1923, resulted in a break from the past political organization and it involved the re-distribution of political power among different actors in society. New doctrines were adopted such as laicism, nationalism, positivism, solidarism and progress based on the developments of the Enlightenment, the French Revolution and 19th century scientism. The advent of the Cold War gave rise to the left and right struggle and with the growth of the global economy, doctrines of globalization and Europeanization/Euro-scepticism characterised the political and social spheres in Turkey. The doctrine of political Islam has also played an important role as an alternative to the left-right debate and it shaped the political attitude of 21st century Turkish politics.
